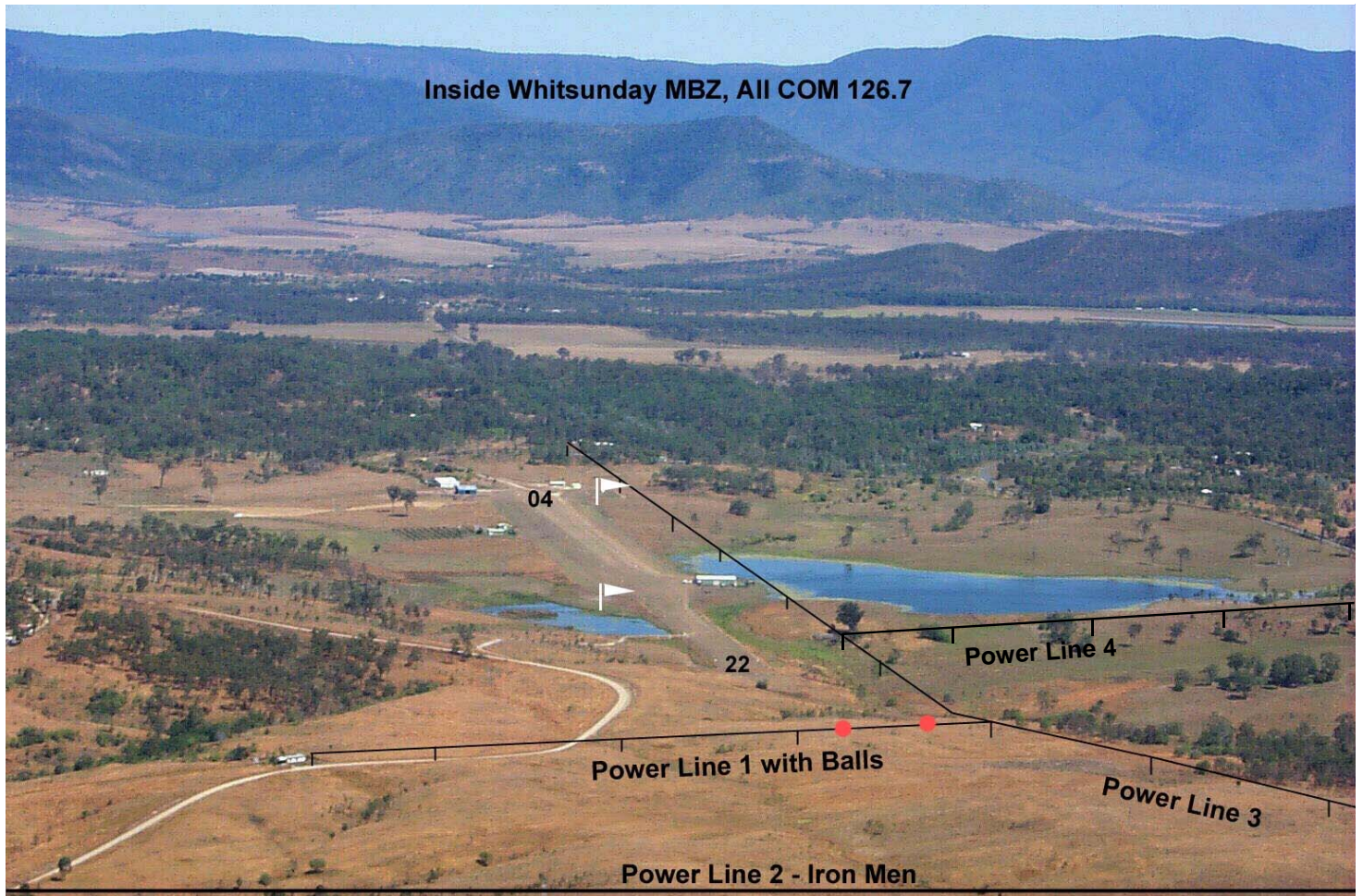


# Lakeside Airpark

## YLAK - Airfield and Landing Information

Inside Whitsunday MBZ, All COM 126.7



### WARNING - POWER LINES

NO BUZZING - This area is not safe for low flying. The country side is a maze of power lines. In the above photo, those in closest proximity to the airstrip have been marked.

**PRECAUTIONS:** We suggest before landing, you do a circuit (1200 ft) to familiarize yourself with the area and to keep your eyes peeled for those power lines.

This is an uphill/downhill runway and as always with such a strip the safe way to handle it is to land uphill (22) and depart downhill 04. All powerlines are below a normal legal glideslope. When landing on 22 (regardless of the windssock's advice) there are **2 big plusses**. As you drop below 200ft agl, the hill shields you from the crosswind or tailwind and regardless of windssock you make a NIL WIND landing, so the crosswind disappears then you touch and the uphill slope makes pulling up easy. **GET THE PLANE ON THE GROUND AND STABILISED BY THE WINDSOCK**, for the wind finds you again at that point. The powerline is hard to spot, but it lines up with the white house on the left. A normal approach is well clear of it.

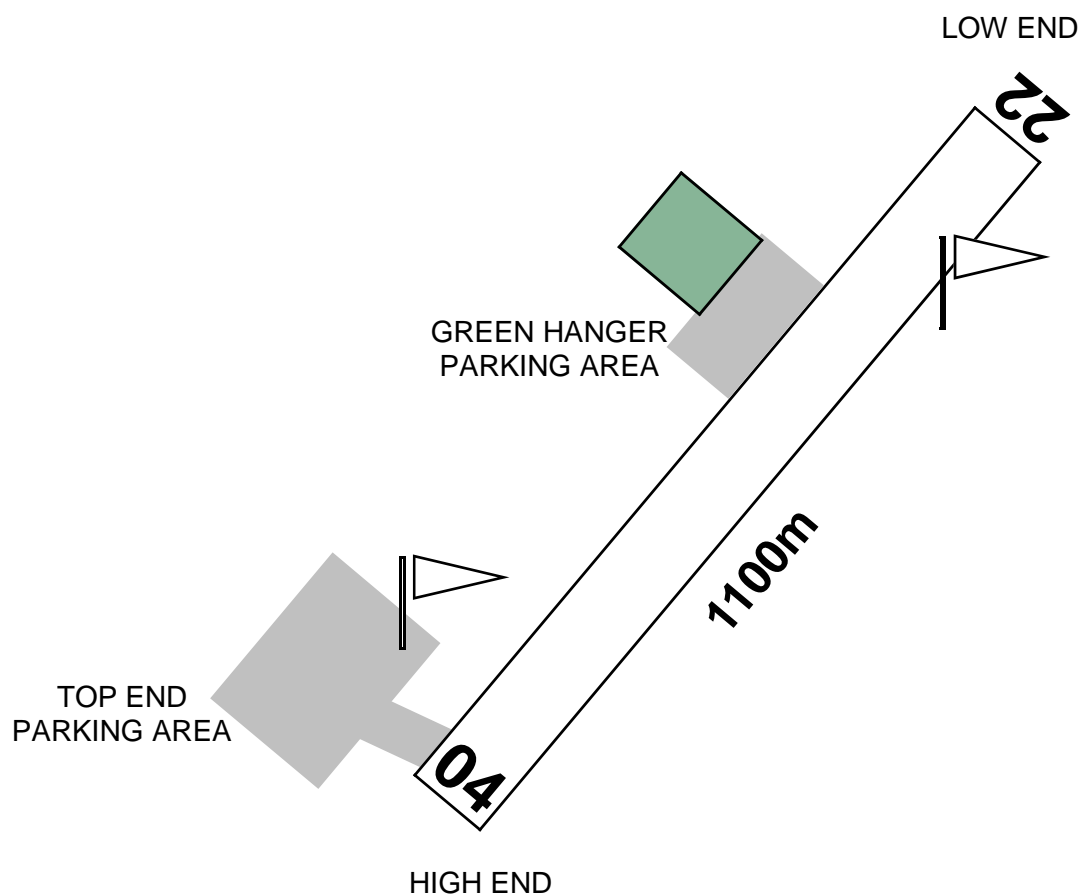
**TAILDRAGGERS:** No problem if you land on 22, no crosswind worries.

When landing on 22 during a SE breeze, you will find apparent sink just before you land because the hill shelters that end of the strip from the wind.

**Look out for birds and kangaroos when taking off and landing, especially around dusk and dawn.**
